To all residents of UMV,

My name is Tricia Keagy, and I am happy to announce that I have been appointed to the position of Health & Wellness Navigator. This is a new position for The United Methodist Village, but I feel it will be a valuable one. What IS a Health & Wellness Navigator? In a nutshell, this person will be able to assist you in connecting to all things wellness, both preventative and reactive intervention. We will be able to provide you with internal and/or external resources for emotional, intellectual, social, spiritual or physical needs and concerns. We are being supported by the Life Care Services Health and Wellness Program where I have attended an on-boarding training in Chicago before starting in this new role. In addition, we participate in weekly conference calls where we can connect with other Health and Wellness Navigators through the USA. This role is different in many communities but be assured that we will grow together with Health and Wellness for each of you. Please keep in mind that we are not able to provide treatment or give injections, but we CAN navigate you in the right direction and provide guidance for any concerns. Sometimes, it is very difficult working through the medical "system". Hopefully, this position will be one that will provide you with the assistance that you need in these areas.

Please allow me to share a little about myself. I am not new to United Methodist Village; I have actually been part of the UMV family for three years. In those three years, I served as a Certified Nurse Assistant in Weston Terrace. While working in this position, I was also in the nursing program at Lewis & Clark Community College. I graduated in May of 2017, took the state boards and received my Registered Nurse License in October of 2017. From February of this year to the present, I was on maternity leave and returned to begin this new role as Health & Wellness Navigator. I am excited about this new position and am anxious to meet and get to know each and every one of you.

The Health & Wellness Navigator office is located in Wiseman Pollock on the third floor next to the elevators. My office hours will be Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8 am to 4:30 pm. You can reach me by calling the WP Reception Desk (466-8662) to be transferred to my extension, or just "stop by". Please keep in mind that I am not part of OSF Healthcare who is here on Thursdays for blood pressure checks, but I will be more than happy to take your blood pressure any day that I am in the office.

I'm very excited to be chosen to help develop and continue the growth of the Health and Wellness Program by launching this new role for UMV. I hope you will be patient as I slowly begin to connect names to faces. Forgive me if I ask you many times over to "tell me again your name?!" I look forward to growing in my new position, learning about each of you and providing you with the service and care you've come to expect from UMV.
